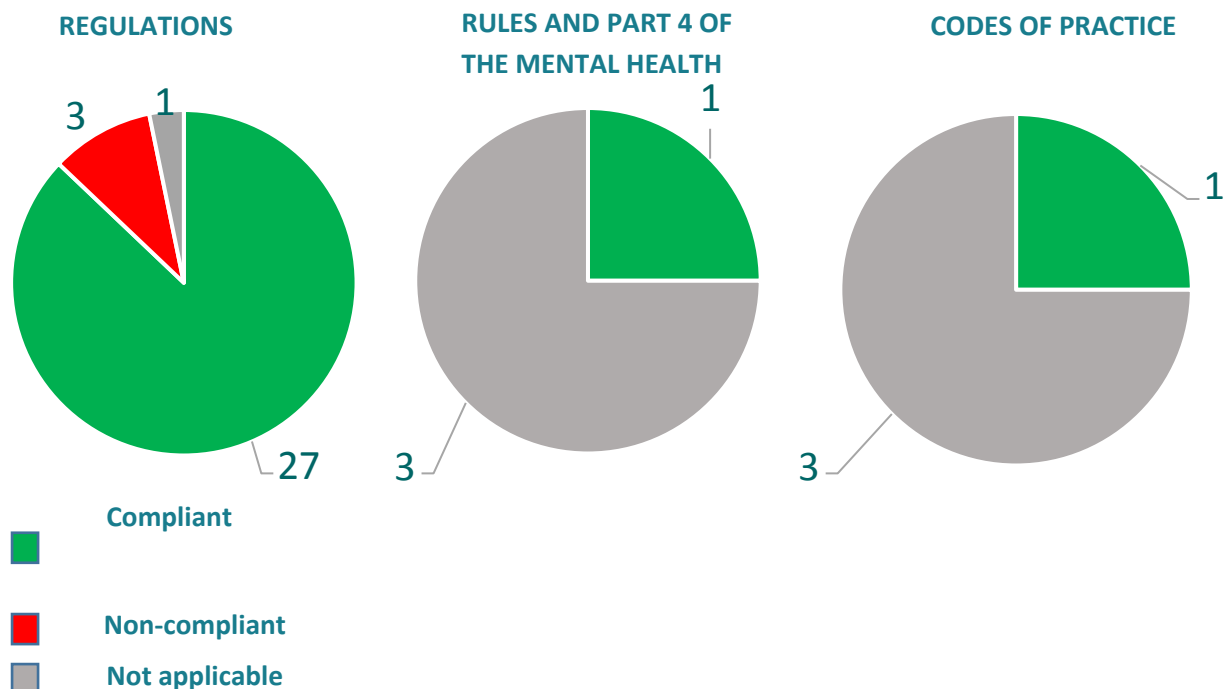

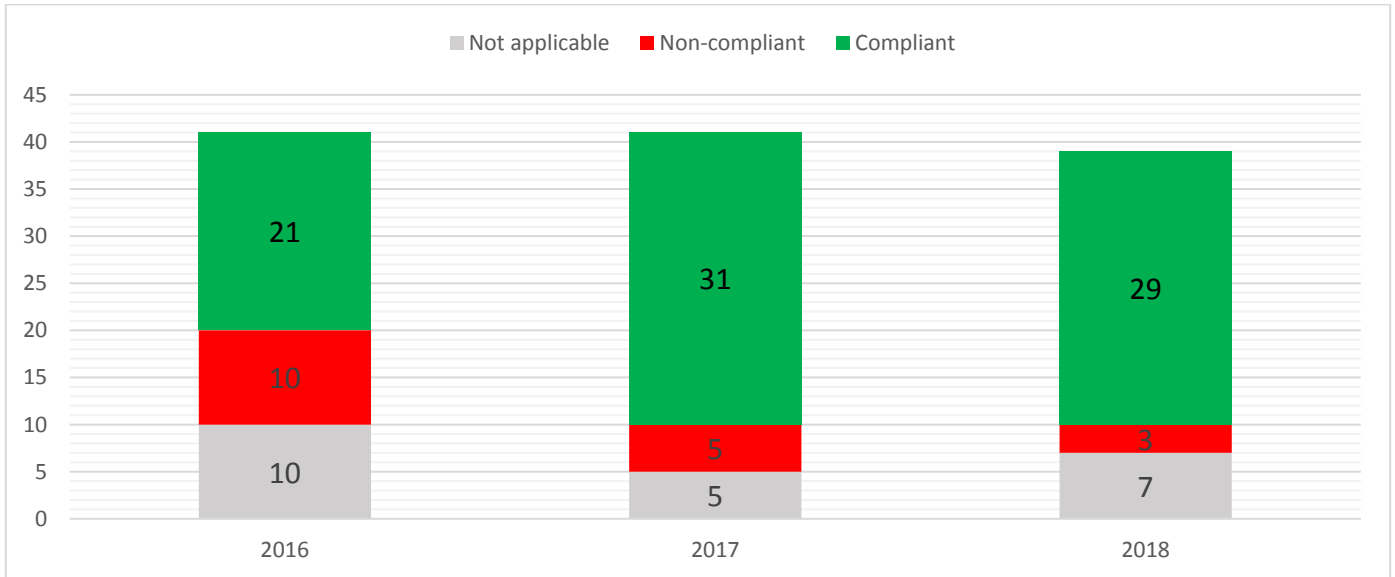

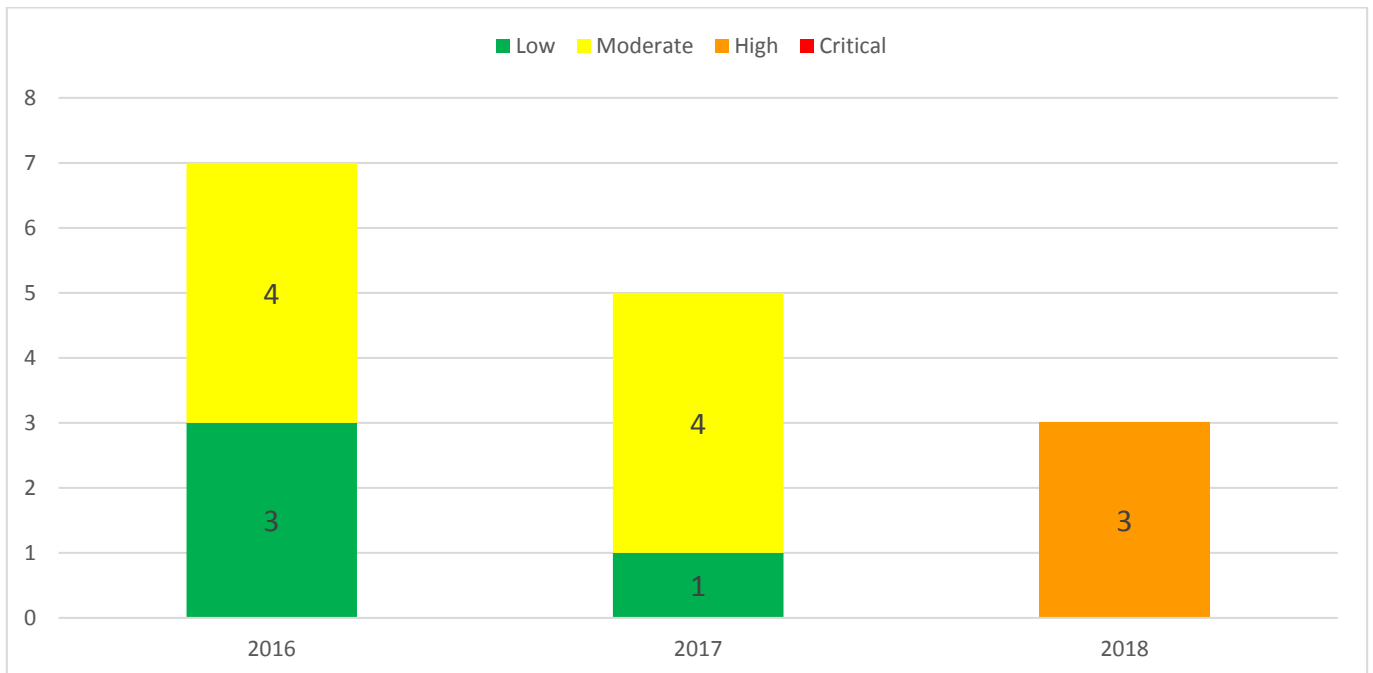

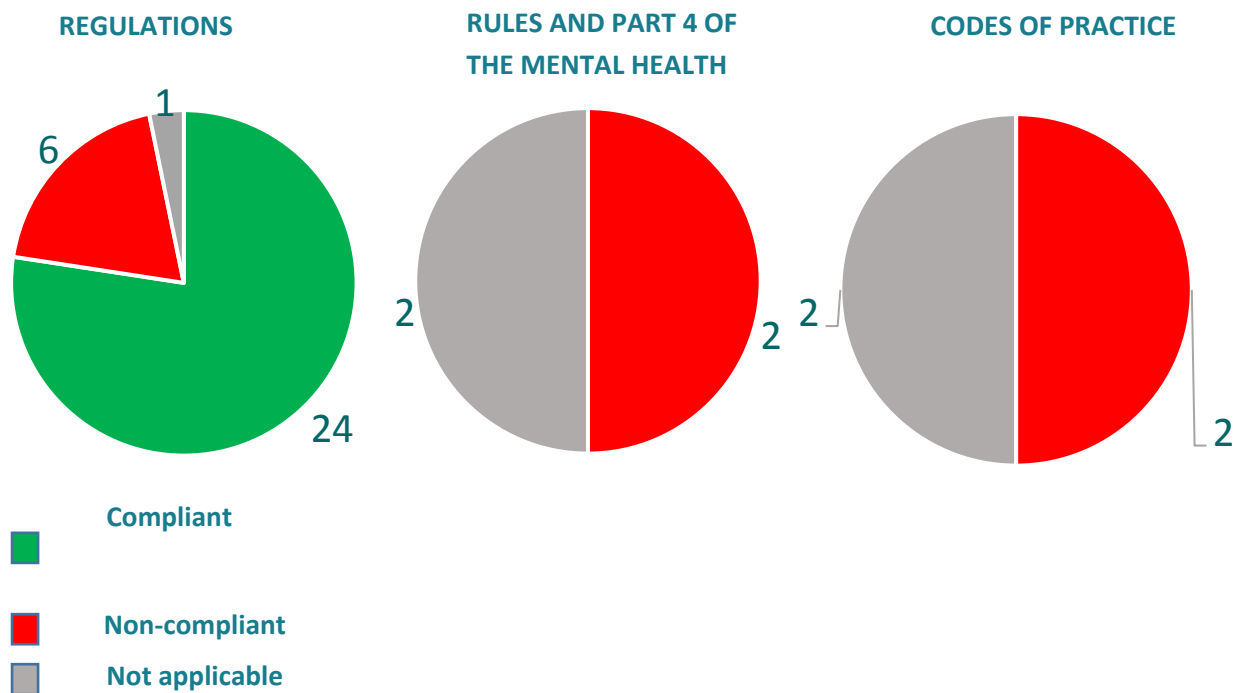

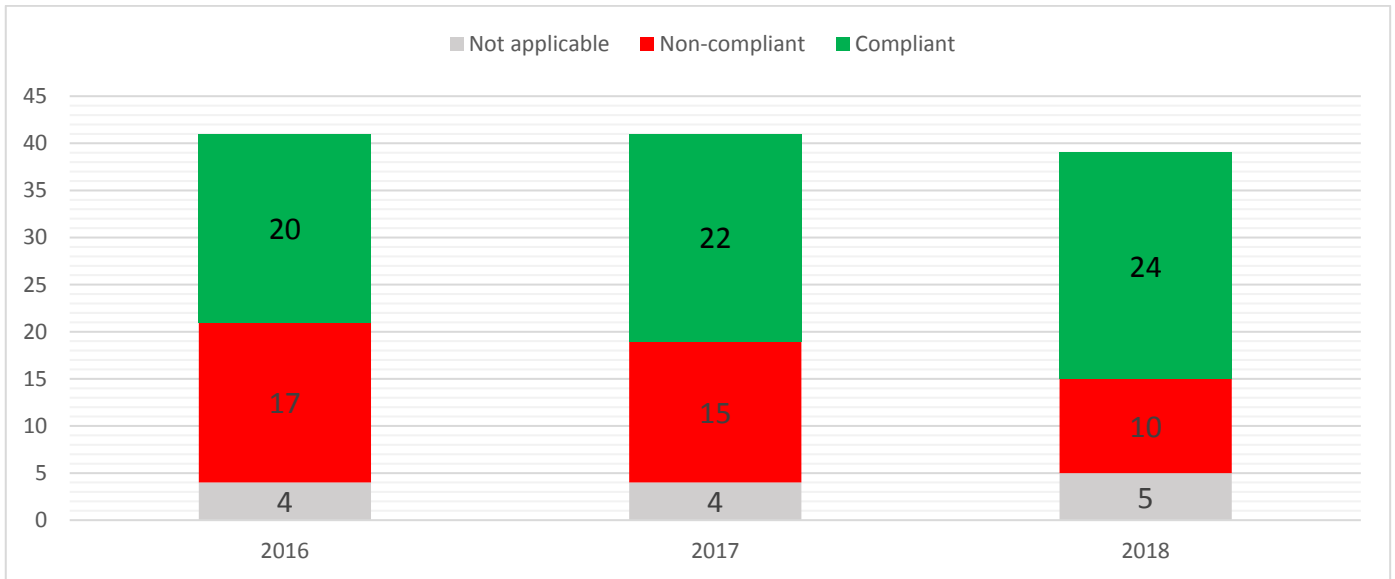

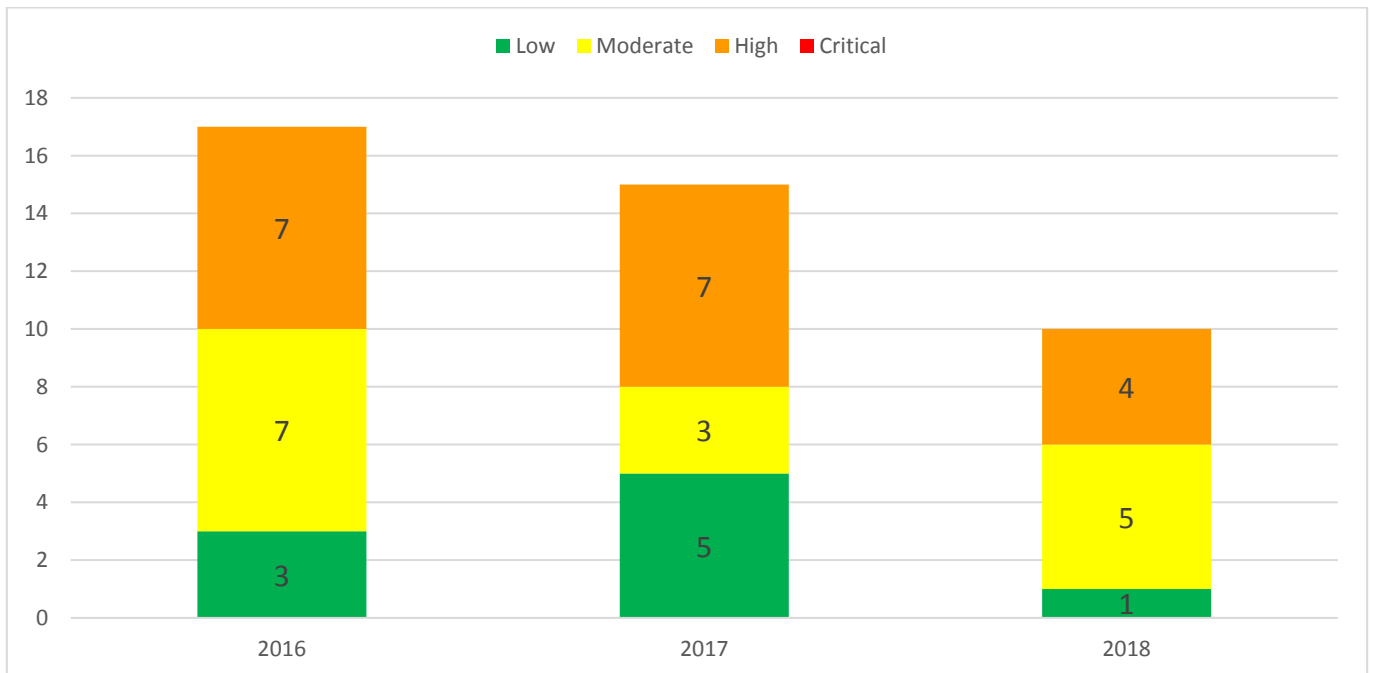

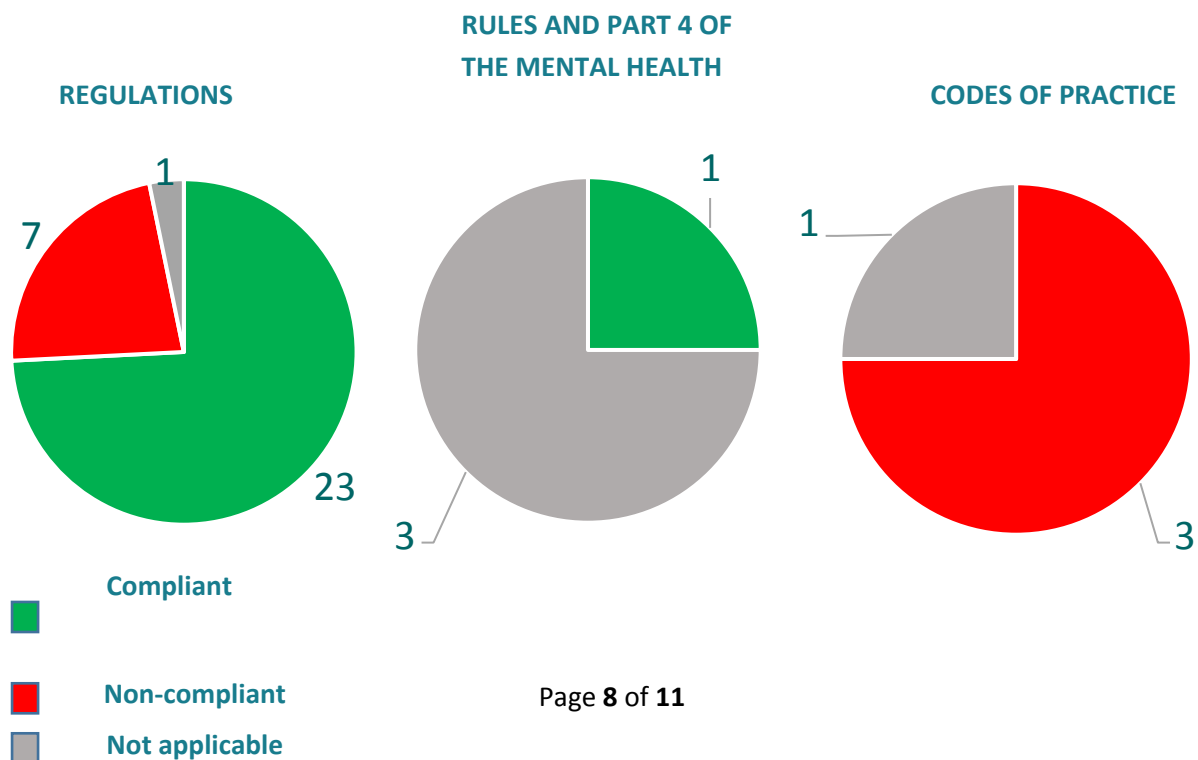

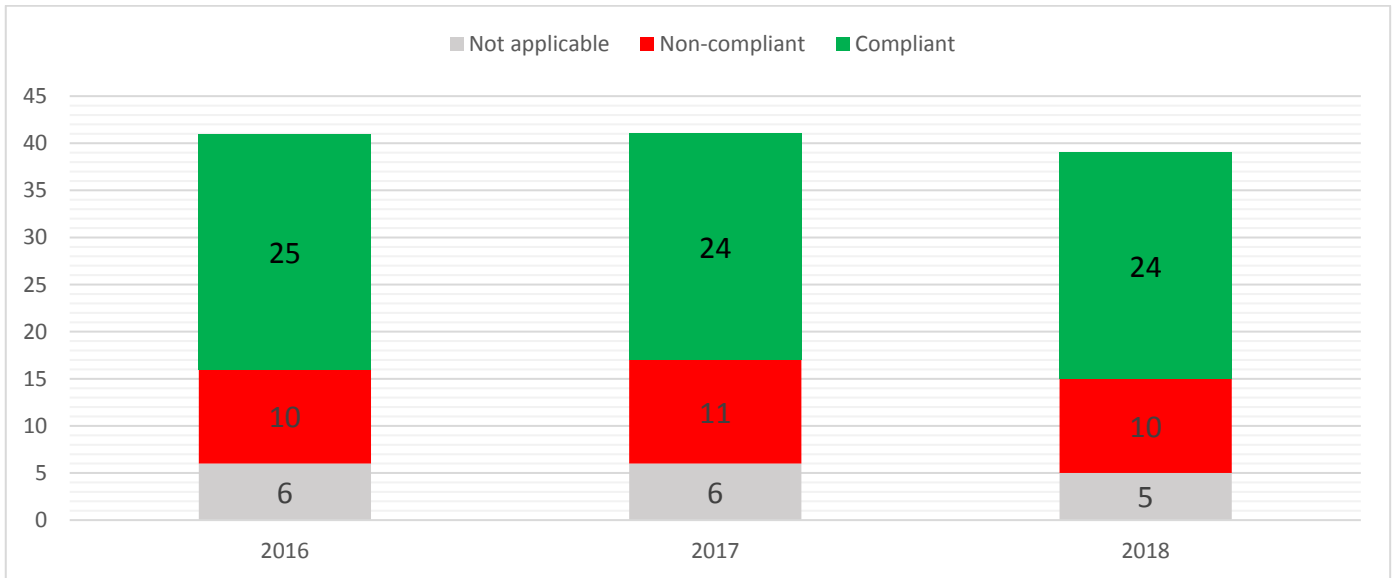

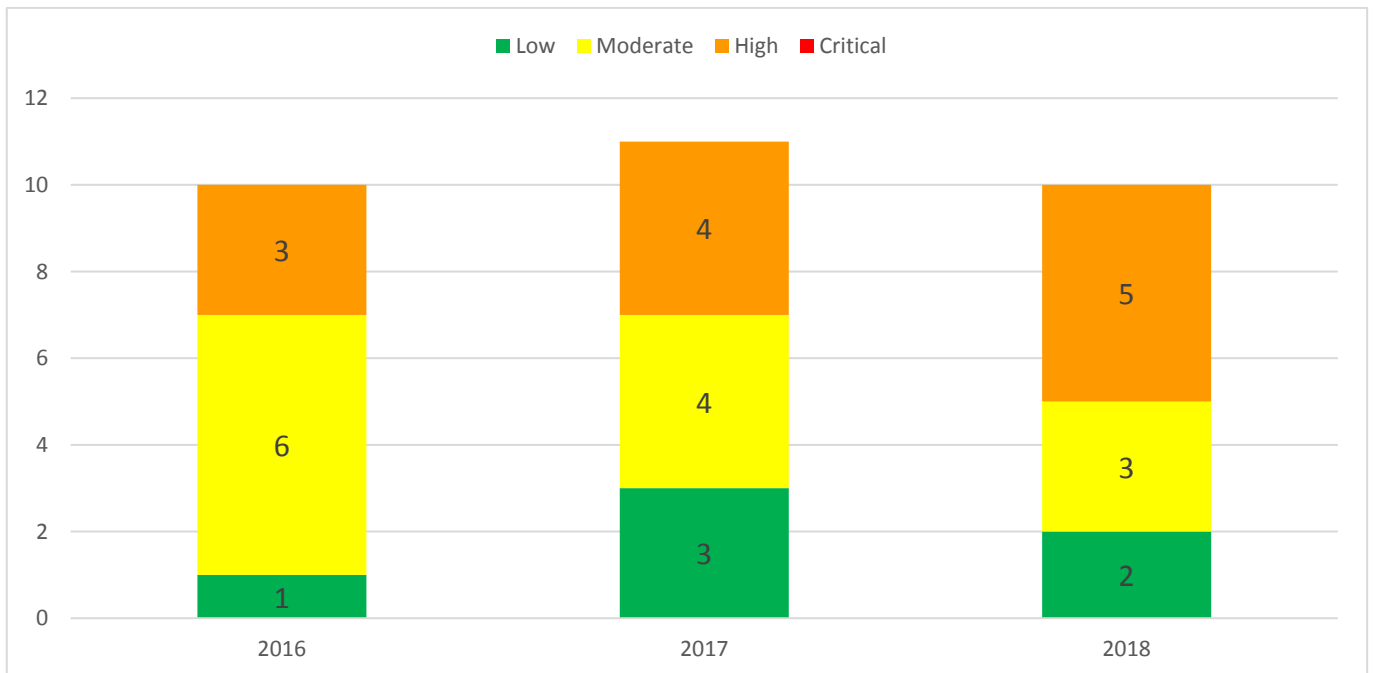

The approved centre shall provide a report on the results of the audits to the Mental Health Commission in a form and frequency prescribed by the Commission.
